

Virtual Meeting High-Level Usage Models—May 2008 Solutions

Stake High Council Meeting

Option 1

Following the guidelines for effective virtual meetings, all members dial in to an audio conference bridge to participate in the meeting.

Option 2

Some members meet in the high council room. The high council room is equipped with a speakerphone and dials in to the audio conference bridge. Others use the speakerphone in the clerk or bishop's office in the local unit. Each building dials in to the audio conference bridge. (This option requires the purchase of speakerphones.)

Option 3

Some members meet in the high council room. The high council room is equipped with a speakerphone and dials in to the audio conference bridge. Others dial in to the audio conference bridge from their homes. Others dial in using a speakerphone in a clerk or bishop's office in their local unit. (This option requires the purchase of speakerphones.)

Stake Presidency Meetings

Option 1

All meeting participants dial in to an audio conference bridge for the meeting.

Option 2

Most participants are in the stake office and use a speakerphone to include the other members in the meeting. (This option requires the purchase of a speakerphone.)

Stake Auxiliary Leader Meetings

Option 1

All meeting participants dial in to an audio conference bridge for the meeting

Option 2

Most participants are in the stake office and use a speakerphone to include the other members in the meeting. (This option requires the purchase of a speakerphone.)

Stake Auxiliary Training Meetings

Option 1

Leaders from all units join a Web conference from their homes. The instructor uses the Web conference to share the training material. All use an audio bridge for the audio portion. (This option requires computers with Internet access.)

Option 2

Leaders from all units join a Web conference from their homes. The instructor uses the Web conference to share the training material. All participants use the voice over Internet protocol (VoIP) capability of the Web conference for the audio portion. (This option requires computers with Internet access.)

Option 3

Leaders meet together at various buildings in the stake. Each building joins the Web conference. All use the VOIP capability of the Web conference for the audio portion. Those who meet in the stake center or wherever the instructor is located do not need to use the computer to see the instruction. (This option requires computers with Internet access.)

Option 4

Leaders meet together at various buildings in the stake. Each building joins the Web conference. All use an audio conference bridge for the audio portion. Those who meet in the stake center or wherever the instructor is located do not need to use the computer to see the instruction. (This option requires computers with Internet access.)

Priesthood Interviews

Option 1

Conduct the interview over the phone.

Option 2

Conduct the interview using a Web conference with the video stream turned on. (This option requires a working Web camera and computers with Internet access.)
