Meetinghouse Firewall

Internet access provided by the Church in meetinghouses must always include an approved meetinghouse firewall: a Cisco 881W, ASA 5505, or PIX 501. Stake and district technology specialists are responsible for making sure the firewall is in place, that it's configured correctly, and that it does not get bypassed.



Please check to make sure an approved firewall is installed and configured properly in each of your meetinghouses with Internet access. It is recommended that firewalls be checked at least quarterly...[View More](#)

Sophos Update

Sophos, is the official meetinghouse computer anti-virus/firewall software, approved for Church-owned computers. If you have or are using other anti-virus or firewall software please remove them and install Sophos.



We have found some instances where Sophos has been disabled, removed or other anti-virus software is being used. We need your help to make sure that only Sophos is installed on Church owned computers.
