

BANDWIDTH GUIDELINES FOR MEETINGHOUSE INTERNET

Summary

These guidelines help Priesthood leaders understand what Internet bandwidth speeds are needed for common Internet uses in meetinghouses.

Using the guidelines below, consider all of the ways each meetinghouse will use the Internet. Order Internet service that will meet or exceed the highest speed needed for each building (this may vary greatly from building to building).
